

Forest Rock Day Nursery

Fee Structure

All fees must be paid in full on or before the 1st of every month.

Any payments that are outstanding after 7th of the month will incur a 10% late payment charge. We reserve the right to suspend your nursery place until your account has been settled after this date. When starting part way through a month invoice will be calculated to reflect the start date, full fees are to be paid before your start date.

Non Funded Fees include nappies, wipes, milk, snacks and meals

Registration Fee – a non-refundable registration fee is required to secure a place at Forest Rock Day Nursery; this registration fee covers the cost of enrolment admin, toothbrushes and a pre-school uniform T-shirt once your child turns 3 years old. There is no refund on this registration fee if you leave the setting before your child turns 3years old. Toothbrushes for the duration of being at nursery will also be provided as part of this registration fee.

Fees - Fees are invoiced monthly in advance. A 'Payment of Fees Agreement' must be completed when registering your child. Payments can be made by BACS, standing orders, company vouchers, via the National Savings Scheme. All payments (including company vouchers) must be received in our bank account by the 7th of the month to avoid the 10% late payment charge being added to your fees.

Parents claiming FEEE

(Free Early Educational Entitlement): If you are the parent of a funded child, your FEEE entitlement will be deducted from your child's sessions, according to the information you have submitted on your Parent Statement of Undertaking (PSOU). All optional costs will be applied to all funded sessions for children in receipt of FEEE unless otherwise indicated on your Clear Offer Agreement.

Enrichment Resources – includes things such as all Arts and Craft materials, including sand, compost, water play enhancements, PPE (Personal Protection Equipment) ie disposable gloves, aprons, Consumables such as Tissue, Toilet paper, Face wipes, Paper towels, Suncream, Anti bac wipes/sprays. This list is not exhaustive.

Quality Provision – includes use of setting's sun hats, wellies, summer and winter wet suits, baking resources, seasonal/celebration resources (ie, Mother/Father's Day, Christmas, Halloween, Diwali, Children in Need, Graduation, etc..), Use of OVIVIO learning journey and parent communication app, In-house PE sessions (3+ years), This list is not exhaustive.

Pre-school uniform- All preschool children (Hoglets and Hedgehogs) are given their 1st T-Shirt, which was paid for within your original registration fee, you can purchase more at an additional cost.

Toothbrush – All children will receive an age-appropriate Toothbrush which was paid for within your original registration fee. Toothbrushes will be replaced by nursery every 4 months or your child's equivalent use of 4 month or when worn. Parent's will be asked to supply their child with age-appropriate toothpaste.

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PLEASE NOTE: All sessions are subject to availability. If your child does not attend their session, full fees must still be paid. This includes any sessions that your child is absent due to child or parent holidays, sickness or Nursery closures, i.e Bank holidays.

If you are in receipt of EYPP (Early Years Pupil Premium or DAF (Disability Access Funding)), you will not be charged for any additional options.
